

**About European Union Directive 2002/95/EC on the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic equipment.**

Dear partners and friends:

On Brussels, 27 January 2003, the European Community Council and Parliament approved 2002/95/EC Directive regarding to the restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic equipment, Directive known also as its acronym RoHS.

This European Union Directive determine not allow substances and set an specific time limit to get the exemption in devices or products from affected sectors.

These hazardous substances includes: Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium, and PBB & PBDE found in plastics. On 1 July 2006 all electrical or electronic products will have to be exempted of these substances to be sold in European Union.

RELECO, S.A., has done the necessary arrangements to get all his products in observance with this European Directive. We hereby certify that all Releco products had been manufactured in observance of RoHS Directive from January 2006.

At the date of this certificate, we hereby confirm that 100% of Releco products are manufactured in observance of European Directive 2002/95/EC.
